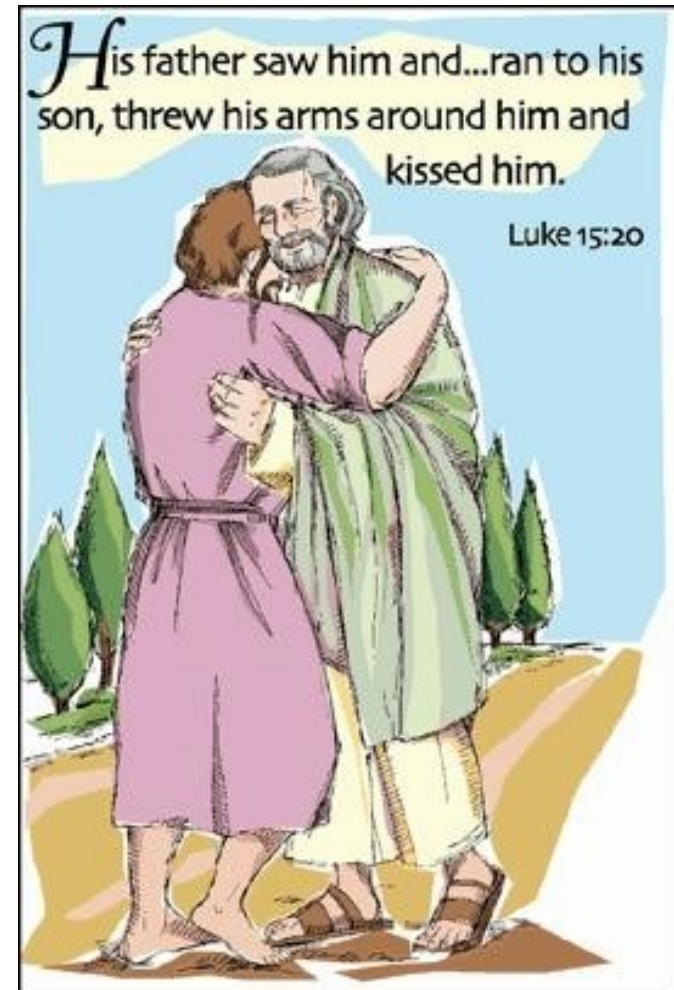

Camp Manitoqua has been a place where young men and women from our area, and from all over, have gone to experience the presence of God in a special way. During the pandemic they have been hit hard financially. Due to heavy restrictions in Illinois they have hardly been able to host campers since last March, which is their primary source of income. This tragedy has presented us with an opportunity to serve those who have served us for so long. We have 38 spots available for anyone who is willing and able to come and serve by doing mission work in many different capacities. There are opportunities for nearly all levels of ability whether young or old, so if the Holy Spirit is speaking to you to go, then know that the Lord can use you there.
