## **Pastor's Notes**

#### Engaging With God through His Word and Prayer in 2023

Proverbs 7:2-3 - "Keep my commandments and live, and my teaching as the apple of your eye. Bind them on your fingers; Write them on the tablet of your heart."

Have you ever noticed how God's word is powerful in changing everything about your life? It aligns you more closely with the heart of God because He and His word are one!

Below are five ways you can engage more deeply with God's word this year so that your life will look, feel, and be more like Christ's. May this list help you in your personal pursuit of God's word. May you be encouraged to engage with it more deeply this year than ever before!

#### 1. Prioritize Quiet Time

It is difficult to sustain a Christian lifestyle on bits and pieces of a Sunday sermon or a bible study. Being quiet before the Lord every day deepens your relationship with Him, and in turn, it strengthens your ear to hear Him speak to you. Engaging the Word of God is no good if you don't prioritize engaging the actual person of God and doing so daily.

#### 2. Choose a Scripture a Day to Meditate On

After you completed your quiet time with the Lord, you will discover how easy it is to not meditate on what you've studied. To meditate means to think deeply or carefully upon, or to rehearse something for a period. The more you surround yourself with God's Word, the more it will become embedded in your heart and mind. This deep engagement will change your life!

#### 3. Talk About the Word in Your Day to Day

This is a fascinating way to engage the Word of God! Incorporating it into the rhythms of your life is, essentially, what makes you more like Christ! Try weaving Scripture into your normal routine like cooking dinner or watching TV. There is a Scripture verse or passage for every part of your life! You don't need to be deep; it can be as simple as asking yourself, "Am I cooking food that will build my temple (body) and strengthen it, or is this meal hurt it or tear it down?" Do the same when watching television! It is much easier to live by God's word when you apply it to the regularities of your life.

#### 4. Flip Moments of Frustration or Anger into Teachable Moments

God has given you emotions, and most of the time, but not all the time, you are justified in feeling the way you feel. What matters is how you interact with those emotions! So, when you feel frustrated or angry, take the emotion as a sign that God's word needs application into the situation. Be on guard! Scripture reminds us to engage Scripture in the hard moments. These hard, emotional moments test your ability to submit to Christ's lordship over your life!

#### 5. Invite the Holy Spirit into Your Prayers

Prayer is your direct communication to your Heavenly Father. In prayer you understand who you are and what God wants of you. Through prayer you build a beautiful relationship with Him. Sometimes, your prayers are convoluted with your own desires verses God's desires. Asking for personal needs and desires in prayer is fine, but that shouldn't be the primary reason. Pray to know God's will and understand what He desires, so you can walk in His desires. Ask the Holy Spirit to be an active participant. Speak to Him, and then, be still and allow Him to speak to you. The Holy Spirit knows the secrets of Heaven, and He reveals all things to you as He is led by the Father (1 Cor. 2:10-12). He knows the mind of God and will help you to pray effectual prayers!
