We are working on getting some bigger vehicles to fit more people in, but if you want to go with just your car full, that is fine. Cost will be \$10 a ticket plus food when we stop on the way down and parking.



The Evangelism/Outreach Pillar is planning a Family Mission Trip to the Appalachian region in Southeast Kentucky. We will be leaving Brandon on Sunday, July 14 and stay until Friday, July 19. When we leave on Friday morning we will be stopping at the Ark Encounter in Williamstown, Kentucky and will then stay overnight Friday and return home on Saturday, July 20. We will be lodging at Twin Rocks Bible Camp in Viper, Kentucky and helping the local community in Hazard, Kentucky.

The cost is \$100 per person for up to 20 people. If we have 21 or more going the cost will be \$50 per person.

Registration is due by May 14, 2024.

For now we are limiting the minimum age to middle school children when accompanied by a parent.
