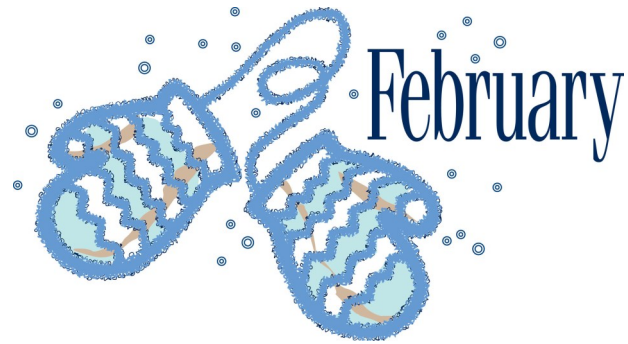

Community Prayer Service – Join us for a Community Prayer Service as we draw closer to God through prayer and worship on Sunday, March 10th at 7pm at Alto Reformed Church, N3697 Cty Rd EE, Waupun.



The Evangelism/Outreach Pillar is planning a Family Mission Trip to the Appalachian region in Southeast Kentucky. We will be leaving Brandon on Sun., July 14 and stay until Fri., July 19. When we leave on Friday morning we will be stopping at the Ark Encounter in Williamstown, Kentucky and will then stay overnight Fri. and return home on Sat., July 20. We will be lodging at Twin Rocks Bible Camp in Viper, Kentucky and helping the local community in Hazard, Kentucky.

The cost is \$50 per person and will be refunded if they attend. If we have 21 or more going the cost will be \$50 per person.

Registration is due by May 14, 2024.

For now we are limiting the minimum age to middle school children when accompanied by a parent.
