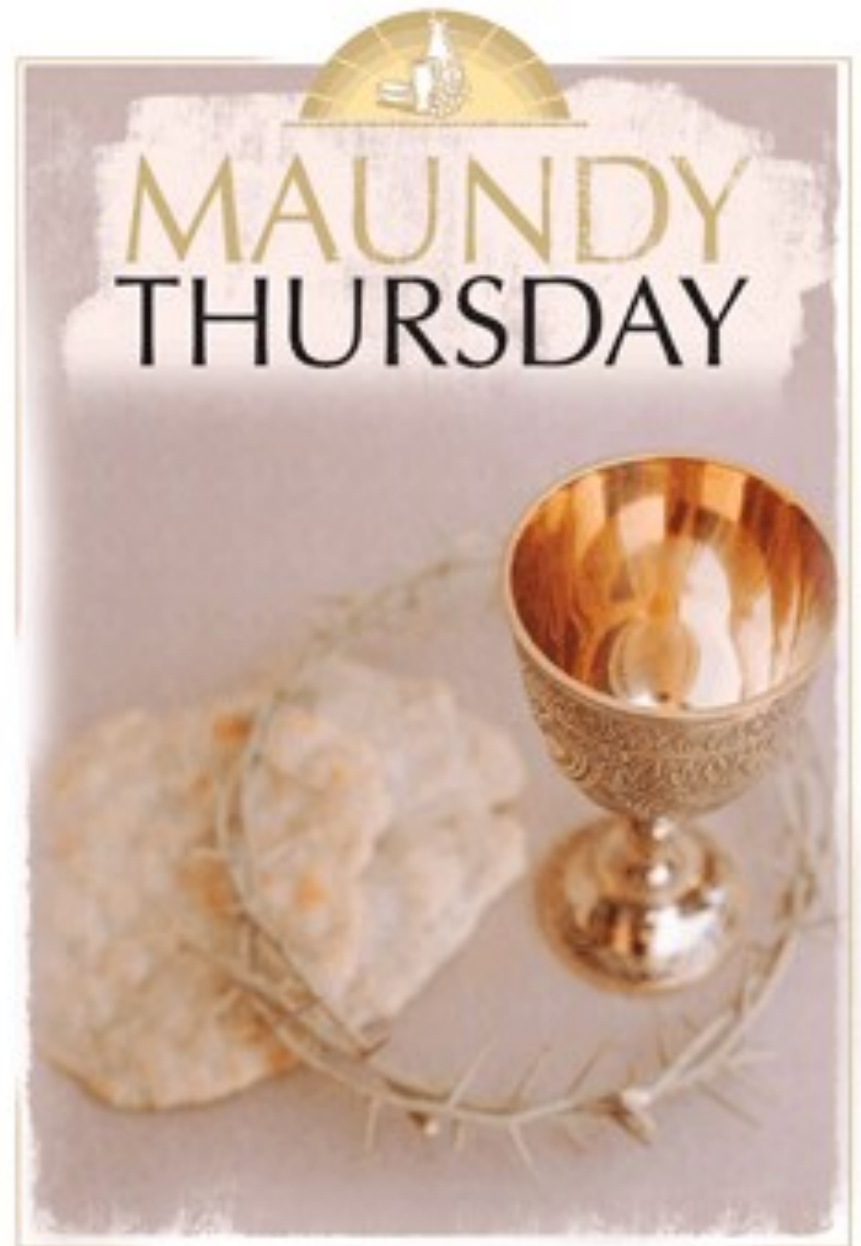

Maundy Thursday marks the Last Supper, where Jesus shared bread and wine with his disciples, symbolizing his body and blood, and instituted the practice of communion

Foot Washing— Jesus also washed the feet of his disciples, a humbling act of service that became a model for Christians to serve one another.

Historical Significance—The Last Supper took place during the Jewish Passover, which Jesus transformed into the Last Supper to commemorate his sacrifice.

Christian Observances— Many Christians observe Maundy Thursday with special communion services, foot washing ceremonies, or other acts of service.
