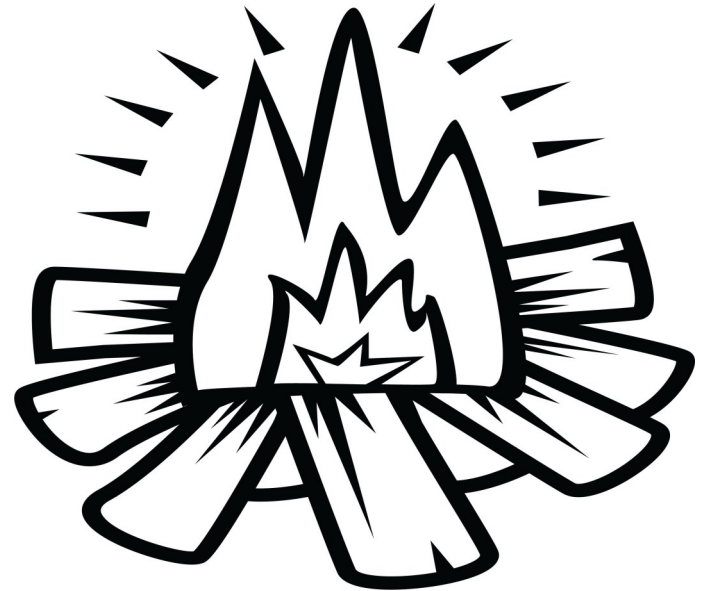
Children's Bulletin-Bulletins may be taken home but we ask that the crayons be returned to the baskets following the service.
